AUO takes all reports of potential antitrust issues seriously and will not penalize or retaliate against anyone in any way for providing information to the Legal Office or Dr. Lin, or reporting any potential violation, in good faith. Any incidents of retaliation should also be reported to the Legal Office immediately.
